

## **PRIVACY NOTICE**

Effective Date: October 1, 2022

This Privacy Notice ("Notice") describes the practices of the EV Charging Expansion Project and its Project Management Team on behalf of the EV Charging Expansion Project Environmental Remediation Trust (the "Project", "we", "our") with respect to personal data that the Project collects through the EV Charging Expansion Project website (the "Site").

This Notice applies only to personal data collected through the Site. "Personal data" means information that identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular individual. This Notice does not apply to personal data that the Project may collect or obtain through other means, such as in person, via email, or via telephone, or to personal data that any electric vehicle chargers provided by the Project collect and use.

We may update this Notice from time to time. If we make changes, we will revise the "Effective Date" at the top of this Notice. Changes to the notice will become effective once posted. We encourage you to check back from time to time to ensure familiarity with the most current version of the Notice.

### **INTENDED USERS OF THE SITE**

The Site is directed to representatives of businesses interested in applying for free electric vehicle chargers for installation at qualifying locations ("Businesses"). This Site is not intended for use for personal, family, or household purposes. We do not knowingly collect personal data from children under the age of 18 through the Site. If a child has provided personal data through the Site, we ask that a parent or guardian contact us, and we will delete the information about the child that we can identify from our files, except as required or permitted by law.

### **PERSONAL DATA**

The personal data that we collect from you when you use the Site may include:

- Identifiers such as:
  - First and last name,
  - E-mail address,
  - Phone number.
- Other identifiers that permit the physical or online contacting of you or the Business.
- Information that the Site collects online and maintains in a personally identifiable form in combination with an identifier described above.
- Communication preference information, such as the best time to contact you or the Business.
- Installation information, such as the installation location and number of chargers requested.

- Contents of communications submitted to the Project.
- Information that we collect automatically about use of the Site, such as through data technologies like cookies.

## **USE AND DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL DATA**

We use the personal data above for the following purposes:

- Operate, administer, and improve the Site.
- Evaluate and manage applications for EV charging units.
- Fulfill orders and carry out transactions requested, including but not limited to delivery and installation of EV chargers.
- Fulfill tax compliance obligations.
- Fulfill legal and regulatory obligations, including satisfying the requirements of applicable court orders.
- Detect and protect against security incidents and malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity.
- Satisfy other legitimate business interests.
- Communicate with Businesses about the Site and status of the Business's application, order, installation, or transaction.

The Project will not disclose personal data covered by this Notice to others except for the purposes described above, when we have permission, or to the categories of third parties listed below.

### **Vendors**

The Project may disclose personal data to third party suppliers or service providers ("Vendors") in connection with such Vendor's supply of products, such as EV chargers, or performance of services, such as operation of the Site, evaluation of applications, fulfillment of orders, and installation of EV chargers. The Project will not authorize such Vendors to disclose or use the information for purposes unrelated to the supply of such products and performance of such services.

### **Compliance with Law and Protection of Legal Rights**

We also may disclose information about you (i) if we are required to do so by law, regulation, or legal process (such as a court order or subpoena), (ii) in response to requests by government agencies, such as law enforcement authorities, or (iii) when we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to prevent physical harm or financial loss or in connection with an investigation of suspected or actual fraud or illegal activity.

### **Business Transactions**

We reserve the right to transfer any information we have about you in the event we sell or transfer all or a portion of our business or assets (including in the event of a reorganization, dissolution, or liquidation).

## **TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES**

When visitors interact with the Site, as with many other Web sites, certain information is automatically collected about the visit through tracking technologies such as cookies. A cookie is a small text file that is placed on a hard disk by a Web server. Cookies contain information that can later be read by a Web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you. The information the Site collects through tracking technologies may include Internet protocol (IP) address, which is the number assigned to a computer whenever it is connected to the Internet, device operating system, screen settings, Web browser software, and referring Web site.

The Project may use this data for the purposes described above under "Use and Disclosure of Personal Data."

## **COMBINED AND AGGREGATED INFORMATION**

Information collected automatically may be combined with other personal data to improve the Site or for the purposes described above under "Use and Disclosure of Personal Data". Personal data may also be de-identified by removing any information which might allow a Site user to be identified or contacted and combined with non-personal data of other users of the Site. The Project may use or disclose this non-personal data for the purposes above or for other purposes.

## **PRIVACY CHOICES**

Web users have the ability to accept or decline cookies and certain other tracking technologies by adjusting the settings in their Web browsers. If you choose to decline or block cookies, some Site features may not function properly. The Site does not respond to "Do Not Track" signals at this time.

## **SECURITY**

We maintain measures designed to protect personal data through physical, administrative, and technical safeguards. Despite these measures, we cannot guarantee, and visitors to the Site should not expect, information transmitted over the Internet to remain completely secure.

## **LINKED INTERNET SITES**

The Site may include links to third party sites. The inclusion of any third-party link does not imply the Project's endorsement of such third-party site, or the products and services offered at such third-party site. The Project is not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of such third-party sites. Please note that if you link to a third-party site from this Site, any information you provide on that site is not subject to this Notice.
